## INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE NOVEMBER 28 - 29 2013

In Prague on 23rd May 2013

## Dear Mr. Milan Broža,

Let me address you with an invitation to participate in and a polite request from the United Nations to become a patron of the international conference which we are preparing to be held in Prague on  $28^{th}$  and  $29^{th}$  November.

In September 2012, the ceremonial gala evening took place in Prague where the awards of the international competition GOLDEN DECIBEL - Décibel d'Or were given. The jury consisted of 72 experts from 13 countries and they selected candidates for the awards from hundreds of registered projects. Personalities from 11 European countries and Israel took part in the award ceremony. The general patron of the international competition was the Minister of Environment, Tomáš Chalupa.

Already during negotiations of the jury, there were opinions initiating a global approach to reducing noise in the environment and proposals for spreading the air pollution issue. In the ceremonial gala evening on  $27^{\text{th}}$  September 2012, it was decided to organize a representative international conference aiming at the state of the air pollution and noise in cities.

It is the year 2013 and each of us realizes that the price of human life is and will be always priceless, and also that a human life is determined especially by the environment we live in. For most people, regardless of their political orientation, religious belief or place on the planet, the health is the most important life value. Nevertheless, many of us do not realize risks connected with the living in big world cities. Every day, we are exposed to air pollution and high levels of noise in such extent which deteriorates the life quality of urban population alarmingly.

We are confident that it is needed to repeatedly warn of these risks and to solve the issue in an active way. In 2003, the group of first eight big European cities with the European Commission and the WHO for Europe tried this, but after 10 years, the situation is much worse and no conceptual and coordinated effort resulted from the Berlin premiere.

For this reason we chose the name of the conference *Reducing noise and air pollution in cities to improve the health of the population*, with the motto **BETTER CITIES FOR BETTER LIFE**, and after ten years we want to achieve realistic goals. Not only that this year, it will be 10 years since the Berlin conference was held but the year 2013 is announced by the European Commission to be the year connected with the struggle for a better air.

Furthermore, we believe that just the United Nations is the best partner for such projects of which participants will be mayors of capitals of EU members and candidate cities, and about 70 cities outside the EU (i.e. New York, Moscow, Rio de Janeiro, Cairo, Beijing, Shanghai, Tokyo, Tel Aviv and Jerusalem). This happens especially in the situation when more then ever we are aware of how much lifestyle diseases exist, how much urban citizens' lives are shortened due to the effects of the pollutants and how many of us die early and unexpectedly. These factors are undoubtedly associated with the quality of the environment, which is crucial for the survival of future generations. Because what else than the preservation of the natural environment we live in, and the global, sustained and intensive protection will allow our children to live a high-quality and rich life.

We expect the participation of departmental commissioners, as well as representatives of the WHO. The Association of Towns and Municipalities of the Czech Republic showed interest in the participation of 120-150 mayors of Czech and Moravian towns and villages.

We discuss the co-organization of the capital city of the Federal Republic of Germany with the Mayor of Berlin, Klaus Wowereit.

The First Deputy Prime Minister and the Minister of Foreign Affairs, Karel Schwarzenberg, provided us with his patronage and diplomatic corps for intensive negotiations on the participation of representations of cities from all over the world.
